As a result of significant investment in developing and expanding the facilities, Shannon is now a major storage and distribution point for road fuels and petrochemicals offering services such as road tanker loading, drumming, and blending.

History and development

Shannon Terminal was acquired in the 1970s when it was a small oil distribution terminal. The petroleum operation at the site has since been greatly expanded, and the company has also invested in developed facilities for handling petrochemicals as well as new road loading and handling capabilities for road fuels.

Technical skills

Shannon Terminal's strategic location at one of the few deep



water ports in that part of Ireland makes it a focal point for the distribution of oil and chemical products throughout the country.

Many of the terminal's particular skills have been developed to support this position – and this has been backed up by major investment.

The terminal is one of Ireland's major storage and distribution points for road fuels. Investment here has included new road tanker loading and blending facilities to meet the most stringent vapour containment requirements.

The terminal can also handle solvent drumming and packaging for the pharmaceutical sector. Further investment here has provided blending and packaging facilities to provide specialised products and blends to Irish industry.
