




Mannheim North, Germany

Occupying a prime location on the River Rhine, western Europe's principal inland waterway, the terminal provides convenient links to southern Germany, France, Switzerland, Austria and Italy, as well as efficient access to Europe's major ports of Rotterdam, Amsterdam and Antwerp.

The terminal provides specialist storage and handling for a broad spectrum of products and has specific expertise in storing a wide range of chemicals and mineral oils, including high-flash-point storage. The facilities are configured to maximise logistical flexibility for customers, with road and rail loading and product transshipment services via barge, rail and truck. The terminal participates in the CDI-T (Chemicals Distribution Institute – Terminals) inspection programme.

History and development

Inter Terminals' Mannheim terminals have a long and successful track record of

supplying bespoke storage, handling, blending, and distribution services across the complete spectrum of the chemical, petroleum and petrochemical industries.

Technical skills

In addition to its prime location, Mannheim North Terminal has a wealth of technical expertise in bulk liquid storage and handling. The facility has an overall storage capacity of 89,000m³ and offers carbon steel and stainless steel tanks in a range of capacities to suit individual storage needs.

To meet specific product requirements, tanks may be heated, lined, and equipped with nitrogen blanketing systems or recirculation systems for product homogenisation.

Specialist blending services can be provided for various products.

Semi-automated drumming facilities are available for direct filling of barrels or IBCs.
