The Port, which is operated by Copenhagen Malmö Port (CMP), is ice-free all year round and has no tidal restrictions. Providing a logistics hub for the Baltic Region, the terminal offers excellent sea connections and convenient road and rail links to Copenhagen in Denmark via the Øresund Bridge and to central Europe through Denmark. The terminal has an extensive range of tank capacities up to 20,000m<sup>3</sup> across 27 tanks and offers potential for future growth.
